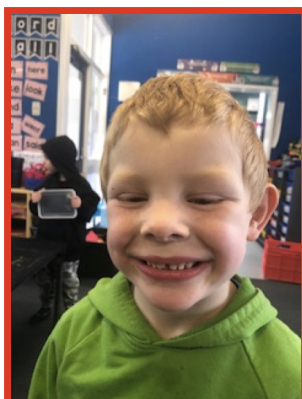
Finally, Our lost property is beginning to bank up. If you feel that you may be missing the odd hoodie or jacket please swing by the office and check it out.

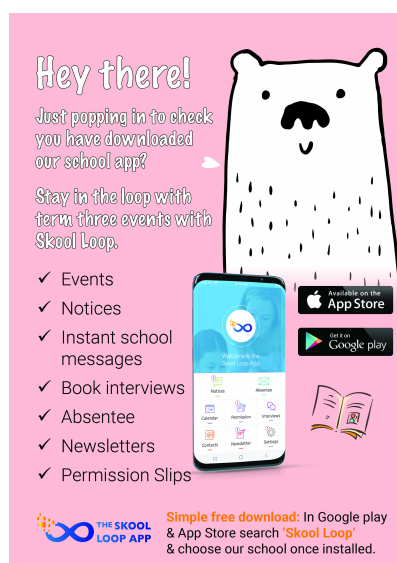
